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The breakdown of the Soviet Union that led to a civil war in Tajikistan, left very little room for the great masters of ballet choreographers and artists. The vacuum created by their absence eventually brought the Tajik ballet down.

It was during a performance for President Emomalii Rahmon in the Sadreddin Aini State Academy of Opera and ballet theatre of Tajikistan, that technical failure interrupted the performance. Thwarted by the situation, President Rahmon ordered the closure of the opera house and personally oversaw the reconstruction of the Opera House. He then created a scholarship program to send students to Perm, Russia to study ballet and planned on reviving ballet in Tajikistan.

Nima Kiann the principal choreographer and artistic director of Les Ballets Persans, was invited to Tajikistan to introduce his repertoire of neo-classical and modern ballets to the Tajik dancers and audiences.

The following performance represents one of the first steps the young National Ballet of Tajikistan is taking in the direction of a more modern company capable of performing classical and modern ballet on international tours. Within the frames of the European Youth Dance Project, founded by Nima Kiann in 2007 and for its 9th season, he has brought his repertoire to Tajikistan to start the ball rolling for modern ballet in Tajikistan.

SYMPHONY OF ELEGY

A metaphorical contemporary ballet based on the roots and rituals of lamentation and elegy in the Iranian culture. Recital of an elegy is mainly a performing tradition based on Shahnameh (the book of kings a national epic poem written in 60,000 verses by Ferdowsi in 1010AD) called "Naghali". This form of storytelling is usually done by street performers and entertains audiences while teaching them about Persian mythology and values of heroes.
